



READER GUIDELINES

Do I need to print and bring the text for myself?

No. We will provide the Scripture Reading and the Prayer of the Faithful. They will be prepared for you on the pulpit in a binder.

Where should I sit?

Please sit at the end of one of the first two pews to facilitate easy exit and entrance before and after your reading. Following your reading, kindly return to your pew.

When do I go up to the pulpit?

If you're proclaiming the Scripture Reading, you will be invited forward after the opening prayer, as everyone sits down for the first time; and if you're reading the Prayer of the Faithful, after the priest's homily.

How should I walk up to the pulpit?

When exiting the pew, kindly bow at the front of the Altar and then proceed up the steps to the pulpit.

Can I adjust the microphone on the pulpit?

Yes, please do. It moves easily.

What if I forget what to do?

If uncertain, please look towards the person seated by the statue of Mary who can always gently guide you.

Can I wear sunglasses in case I cry?

Please do not wear sunglasses, but if tears do fall, do not be afraid. Simply take a moment to compose yourself. It's ok!
